## Minutes of the 24 March 2024 Department Meeting

- JWVMHA—DC Weiss provided a short orientation for those not familiar with the organization, history and future plans. P135 member and JWVMHA Secretary Haas recommended members review list of memorabilia and contact living family members to gauge interest in accepting items as donations.

- Old Business
  - Guy Stern Memorial was well attended. Photo is on webpage. JrVC Schenk mentioned he had been contacted about a Congressional Gold Medal for Ritchie Boys.
  - JWV-USA 128<sup>th</sup> Anniversary was held in New York on 15 March 2024
  - Status of FHM Gifts—DC Weiss described EXCOM decisions on Shabbat Candles and Chanukah Menorah and desire to have Fisher House Detroit presentation in the summer before the Detroit Fisher House opens in September. JrVC Schenk outlined policy issues at DVA on display of the Chanukah Menorah and the potential resolution.

  - Sid Lichter reminded all that he was chairman of JWV-USA Awards Committee and sits on board of JWV
    museum.
- DC Weiss introduced the guest speaker, Post 510 member Ethan Gross, who discussed his recent visit to Israel and associated distribution of gift cards to Soldiers in the IDF and family members.
