Minutes of the 21 April 2024 Department Meeting

Approved by EXCOM 9 June 2024

- The meeting, conducted at the Zekelman Holocaust Center (ZHC)i, was called to order by DC Weiss at 1105.
- OOD Adler prepared the Altar.
- DC Weiss led JWV-MI in Honors to the Nation and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- CH Gartner read the opening prayer.
- SrVC Glogower introduced the guest speaker, Mr. Perry Ohren, CEO of Jewish Family Service (JFS) who provided an in-depth description of the history and services of JFS. Of particular note were the following:
 - Current operating budget (\$28 million) is subsidized \$17 million by the Conference on Jewish Claims Against Germany (https://www.claimscon.org/regions/north-america/united-states/) which oversees reparations payments from WWII.
 - JFS provides for basic needs, mental health and wellness support, and support to the elderly to allow them to "age in place."
 - o Bottom Line: JFS was established to help you in your time of need.
