New Business:

- Updated Department By-Laws were voted on and approved unanimously. Most significant change was formal recognition of Patrons. Patrons are now explicitly allowed to vote at the Department level (but not at the National level).
- Election of 2024-25 Officers: Slate is Mark Weiss, Department Commander. Bill Glogower, Senior Vice-Cdr. BG Donald Schenk, Jr. Vice-Cdr. They were re-elected unanimously.
- July 4th Oak Park Parade: We will assemble at the same spot as in previous years-in front of O'Reilly's Auto Parts, northwest corner of the strip mall, 23125 Coolidge Hwy. Parade starts at 11AM. Coolidge Hwy. will close at 10AM. Try to arrive by 10:30AM. Nine Mile Road will be open. We will have 4 cars, including a mini-van, in the parade. We also will shuttle participants back to O'Reilly's after the parade.
- Installation of 2024-25 Officers: DC Weiss introduced Dr. Ed Hirsch, immediate past DC of JWV-MI, to be installing officer (applause). After uninstalling of the old officers, DC Weiss remarked on significant JWV-MI events of the past year. Our sincere thanks to Alan Muskovitz and Art Fishman for informing others locally and nationally of our endeavors. Al reminded us to let him know of activities of interest. On a more somber note, DC Weiss reflected on the concerning events affecting Jews everywhere and our efforts regarding this. Members Mark Reed and Mark Segel will be traveling to Israel July 4th with a new banner signed by us in support. Dr. Hirsch installed Elected Officers Mark Weiss (Commander), Bill Glogower (Senior Vice Commander), and Donald Schenk (Junior Vice Commander). Appointed officers include Lawrence Berry (NEC and NAC Rep), Richard Polk (Judge Advocate), Mark Segel (Quartermaster), Arnold Gartner (Chaplain), Ed Adler (Adjutant), Ron Siegel (Communications), Marc Manson (Historian) and Sid Garbeil (Officer of the Day).
